CRITERIA:

- 1) Previous Coaching experience in a sport, preferably as an accredited Touch Coach
- 2) Previous experience with Juniors and Seniors at a professional Level, i.e. Coach, School Teacher
- 3) Must be able to provide leadership to the members of the Panel
- 4) Should possess the ability to write and edit Technical documents
- 5) Must possess the ability and capabilities to receive and disseminate information
- 6) Must display an ability to work positively with other Directors and Panels
- 7) Must be present at least once annually at a Level One or higher Coaching Course
- 8) High degree of knowledge in the area of Equity issues in Sport

STATEMENT OF DUTIES:

- 1) To work with the Director of Coaching to improve the skills of Juniors in Touch
- 2) To assess the requirements and develop programs to meet the needs of Juniors and Seniors in Touch
- 3) To encourage as many people as possible to play Touch at as high a Level as possible
- 4) To liaise with the Region Executive on participation issues
- 5) To liaise with the NSW Director of Participation
- 6) To assist as requested in the promotion of Touch within the Schools
- 7) To attend meetings as requested
- 8) To plan and implement competitions and development programs in all Affiliates of the Region
- 9) To improve opportunities for women, disabled and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders
- 10) To prepare and recommend policy on Coaching standards and qualifications
- 11) To develop Officials, Referees and Administrative personnel
- 12) To become familiar with the policies in place for the Technical Panel and the other Technical Directorships
- 13) To be involved in Talent Identification Programs within the Region
- 14) To approve awards for talented and progressive participants who show potential for elite competition
- 15) To consistently review development material and resources
- 16) To monitor and evaluate the performance of participants so as to enhance development and submit findings to Technical Panel
- 17) To actively canvas constructive comments, ideas and critiques from amongst the participants within the region
