Camp Objective	To finalise selection of our Boys & Girls 12/14/16's Junior Regional teams, whilst providing players opportunities to learn new skills in a competitive yet fun environment. From the squad final teams of 14-17 players will be selected and published following the camp, aiming for Sunday afternoon 12 May. The camp will include inter-squad trial games, technical skills and drills, interaction with Scorpions mentors and coaching teams and importantly include down time for the players to have fun, relax and enjoy the weekend.
Camp Cost	The cost for the 12's is \$40 which includes Scorp training singlet/shirt and morning/afternoon tea and drinks. The cost of the 14/16's two-day camp is \$160 per player inclusive of all meals (lunch, dinner, breakfast), sports drinks, snacks, accommodation, Scorp training singlet/shirt plus physiotherapy treatment where required.
